

## Criteria to become an Institutional (Reference or Associate) Member of the Swiss Narcolepsy Network (SNaNe)

The Swiss Narcolepsy Network (SNaNe) was created in 2017 and officially launched in 2020. The SNaNe is a non-profit society dedicated to improving care, awareness/knowledge, education and research on narcolepsy and central disorders of hypersomnolence (CDH).

SNaNe board launched several membership categories (individual, junior and institutional) memberships. Affiliated institutional members need to proof excellent expertise with clinical care of narcolepsy and CDH and contribute to the SNaNe database and activities. The database is an important project of SNaNe to promote health care of patients and research about narcolepsy and CDH.

SNaNe maintains two types of institutional membership (reference or associated centers, see below).
